11:30 AM - 11:44 PM	BHB Seat Current Vacancies -Board Status and Update -Review Draft Letter to State Behavioral Planning Council	Jake Wilson, Member At Large	Jake discussed how having a fiscal agent and financial/admin support from annual funds helps sustain board activities. Currently, the board is struggling with member vacancies and lack of attendance at the meetings. Need to recruit more members. Jake discussed how in recent months, Executive committee members met with Empower Idaho and County Commissioners to identify possible fiscal agents. Unfortunately, the conversations were not productive, leaving the board with a continued lack of financial support and putting the board's sustainability at risk long term. Trying to clarify what constitutes a governmental entity. This has created a lot of confusion and nobody to ask for this clarification. The Executive committee put together a letter to the Idaho State Planning Council requesting guidance and support in problem solving the above concerns. The Executive committee is asking the board members for feedback today before submitting the letter. Board members agreed to the letter's content and send it to the council.

			Lesette reviewed the GEO's Reentry program alternative services. They have 7 Connection and Intervention stations that opened in 2020. There is one in each district of the state's Correctional systems.
			The program can serve up to 700 participants at any given time. Currently, they have 400 active participants who are with IDOC and require supervision through GEO.
			Geo is a one stop center to identify and establish services and set up structure for participants. The center teaches critical thinking skills, provides in person and virtual services, education groups, family/parenting groups, vocational services, etc. 1 x month community providers can come in and work with participants.
			Geo is helping to reduce the recidivism rate. They do various assessments including the "Level of supervision inventory." Results are showing a reduction of scores over time while using services. The center implements 2 graduation ceremonies annually.
