Update on the RBHB - Jennifer Burlage and Rebecca Lemmons attended to provide an update on the RBHB. The board is looking for the committees to get the majority of their funding from grants. YBHCB needed clarification as to what the grant writing process will look like. Jennifer and Rebecca explained that the board will assist with the grant writing.
