	Children's Mental Health Crisis/Intake Presentation – Including the Accommodation Registry	Lindsay Harrington & Almedina Toomey	Lindsay and Almedina are from Children's Mental Health in Region 4. They shared a PowerPoint of the crisis services they provide. They also shared the Accommodation Registry that is used in Ada County with both adults and children. This is a specific tool used only in Ada County to increase the communication between LE and Mental Health. When a mental health call is made to LE, they can look in their system to see if an Accommodation Registry has been completed for that individual. If there is one, it will give additional instructions to the LE officer that may help in deescalating a situation more quickly and/or effectively.
